We believe in patient-centered, high-quality, high-value health care. We achieve this care through professionalism, unique knowledge and skills, and the fellowship of the Society's members.





### Foundation Awards and Grants

The primary mission of the Research Foundation of the American Society of Colon and Rectal Surgeons is to raise and award funds to support research and educational programs related to colon and rectal diseases.

### Limited Project Grant (LPG)

**Purpose:** To provide the investigator the opportunity to pursue research interest specifically germane to the field of colon and rectal surgery.

\$50,000/year

### **Career Development Grant**

**Purpose:** Toprovide young surgeons with the support necessary for the initiation and development of an academic career in colorectal surgery. The CDA focuses on career development and mentorship of the individual rather than solely on the research proposal.

\$75,000/year for two years

### **General Surgery Resident Research Initiation Grant**

**Purpose:** To attract General Surgery Residents or recent graduates of such programs into the field of colon and rectal surgery by providing opportunities to engage

in clinical or laboratory-based research focused on diseases of the colon, rectum and anus.

\$20,000

### **Medical Student Research Initiation Grant**

**Purpose:** To provide opportunities for Medical Students to participate in clinical or laboratory-based research focused on diseases of the colon, rectum and anus.

\$4,000

### Training in Research Methodology Grant

**Purpose:** This award aims to provide an opportunity for a graduating Colon and Rectal Surgery resident to attend either the Association for Academic Surgery (AAS) Career Development Course or Fundamentals of Surgical Research Course.

### **Topic Specific Grants**

Grants may also be offered on topic specific research projects germane to the field of colon and rectal surgery. These grants are dependent on donor designation of funds being restricted to a topic that is of interest to them.

### Meet the Challenge Program

Our Meet the Challenge campaign has helped us provide grants and awards in support of research and training in the colorectal field. These ASCRS Research Foundation grants have realized improvements in our understanding and ability to diagnose and treat diseases and disorders such as colorectal cancer, polyps, inflammatory bowel disease and functional disorders.
