## **Preparing Application Materials:**

Applicants will be asked to enter or upload the following information in the web-based portal (list is not inclusive):

## Step 2: Properties

- Select the course you plan to attend.
- Letter of Support from department or division chair, or program chair. (PDF upload)
- Curriculum Vitae (PDF upload)
- Essay: A 500–750-word essay outlining reasons for applying for the fellowship, academic career, research history, career goals and which course the applicant would like to attend and the reason why the applicant believes they would benefit from attending the course. (Open text box)
- Premedical Education (name/location of university, degree, date of graduation)
- Postgraduate Training
  - Internship Institution (from to)
  - Surgery Institution (from to)
  - Other Post Graduate Training Institution (from to)
- Certification in Surgery
  - Name of Certifying Body
  - Date of Certification
  - Certificate Number
- Current Hospital Appointments
  - Hospital, City, Country, Staff Position and From To

  - Institution, City, Country, Position and From To
- Research or Experimental Work

# Step 3: Applicants

- Senior/Key Personnel Applicant
  - Applicant is a Graduating Colon and Rectal Surgeon Resident (no/yes)
  - Applicant is a first-year faculty with demonstrated interest in pursuing academic career in colon and rectal surgery (no/yes)
  - Applicant is a Member or Candidate member of ASCRS in good standing (Member of ASCRS, Candidate Member of ASCRS or no)
